Did you Know?...

Every team has at least two of its final five games at home, one of its last three.

Within each division, each team will have played an equal amount of intradivision games at any point during the season.

Special 'rivalry weeks' will be played throughout the season, during week 5 and the final three weeks (12-14) of head-to-head competition, when every league team will play within its own division.
