SPENDING FRENZY!

**Transaction revenues are up
nearly \$100 from last year!**

FFL team owners have spent almost \$100 more on transactions this year than they spent last year through the first eight weeks of the FFL season. This year's cumulative transaction revenue through the first 8 weeks stands at \$256. 1992's revenue through the first 8 weeks was \$163.00

Maybe the best reason for this increase is the fact that overall scoring is down over 11% from last year. FFL teams have scored 416 fewer points this year through 8 weeks as compared to last year, an average of 35 fewer points per team.

(One other possible reason for the high number of transactions is the popular "transactions" column in the FFF!)

The biggest turnaround from last year belongs to the Virginia team that **STILL DOESN'T HAVE A NAME**. The Nameless team was 6-2 last year at this time, but has slipped to a dismal 1-7 this year. Dallas, Los Angeles, Miami and Pittsburgh have all improved 2 games from 1992.

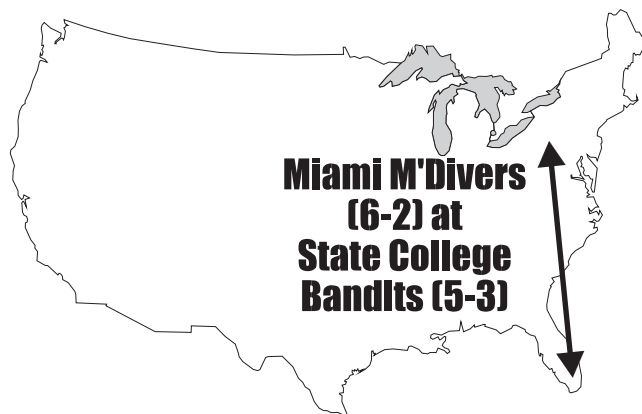

Week 8 Game Summaries

Virginia 41, NJ Kings 47

Hey, hey, hey! The 5-star game of the week turned out to be the closest contest of them all. The battle of the 1-6 teams was won by the Kings, behind a big performance from the King-of-Kings WR Jerry Rice, who pulled in 2 TDs en route to a 155-yard performance.

The "Thrown-in-the-towel" Nonamers actually had this game in reach. Had the Nonamers started Atlanta RB Erric Pegram, his 132-yard rushing performance would have put the Virginia team over the top.

Virginia is reportedly still entertaining offers for future draft picks for several of the players on their roster (RB Terry Kirby is "untouchable," however, according to the Virginia owner.

DS Armadillos 20, LA Riot! 40

The Riot! continues to roll, and remains the league's only undefeated team at 8-0. Riot! RB Barry Foster turned in yet another big performance, with 2 TDs and 87 rushing yards.

The Armadillos continue to struggle, and have fallen to last place in the overall point race. Armadillo's ownership has reportedly been grumbling recently that the rich get richer and the poor get poorer in our league.

Other owners have indicated, however, that smart moves and correct lineups go a long way toward winning. The Armadillos this week started RB Garrison Hearst (out for the year, as reported mid-week on ESPN) and Jay Novacek (off week for the Cowboys). You'd think the owner in Dallas would have heard that the Cowboys weren't playing this week! The Dillo's didn't start RBs Keith Byars or Kenneth Davis, both of whom would have scored FFL points for the Dallas team.

PN Penetrators 39, PA Wildcats 21

RB Thurman Thomas and WR Reggie Langhorne alone scored enough points to beat the hapless Wildcats. Wildcat kickers have fallen into dead last in cumulative season stats and the Cats have fallen to dead last in the Central. The Penetrators win their second game in a row as they try desperately to keep pace in the Coastal Division.

SC Bandits 35, NY Griffons 22

The Bandits manage to stay a game ahead of the pack in the Central Division with a win over the Griffons. Bandits QB Warren Moon looks like he may be finally turning his season around after getting benched two weeks ago in favor of Cody Carlson.

The Griffons fall a game further back behind the LA Riot! in the Coastal Division. The Griffons at 5-3, however, have the best record of all the non-division leading teams. And interestingly enough, the Griffons' 3 losses have been to the 3 division leaders: LA, Miami, and this week to the Bandits.

PG Pachyderms 51, RD Raptors 28

On the weekend before his wedding, PG co-owner David Lieberman avenges the Pachyderms' loss to his brother in week 1. The Pachyderms have scored 107 points in the last two weeks and currently have the league's second-longest winning streak. Pittsburgh QB Brett Favre found his favorite target, Sterling Sharpe, for 4 TDs on the day and came up one point short of tying the season high point total for a QB.

The Rattlin' Raptors had to play without star QB John Elway and monster RB Emmitt Smith. Backup QB Neil O'Donnell passed for the most yards of his career, but the remainder of the Raptors' roster fell far short. The Raptors also made a coaching blunder, starting recently-acquired Steeler RB Leroy Thompson (former Penn Stater!), who was deactivated on Friday after recovering slowly from an injury in week 7.

BR Blowfish 57, MI Muffdivers 36

Blowfish WR Sterling Sharpe came within 3 points of setting the all-time record as the Blowfish reverse a two-game skid. Sharpe pulled in 4 TDs on the day during his 32-pt. performance. The Blowfish could have set the season-high point total had they played RBs Robert Smith and Steeler-killer Eric Metcalf, who had two punt returns for TDs.

The Miami kicking curse continues. Since their kicker snafu, Miami kickers have scored only 1 point in the last 5 weeks. Miami started 6-0, but now falls to 6-2. In 1992, Virginia started 6-0 in the Southern Division and lost their next 6 games. Hmmm...

WEEK 8 TRANSACTIONS:

- State College Bandits drop Rodney "yes, I got two touchdowns the day after I was dropped" Culver, RB, Indianapolis Colts. Bandits add Chris Burkett, WR, 747s.
- Pennsylvania Pussycats drop Jeff "yes, I caught nearly 100 yards of passes after I was dropped" Graham, WR, Pittsburgh Steelers. The Cats add Jeff "Coroner's In..." Query, WR, Bungals. The Cats owner then pondered long and hard over starting Query or Dwight Stone. Ying decided to stick with Stone. Result: Stone fumbled a pass that MIGHT have put him over 60 yds. for the week. Query, who didn't start, caught his third TD pass of the season.
- Pennsylvania continued to add to the transaction coffers, dropping Mike Sherrard, WR, NY Broncos, who was the second Wildcats receiver in as many years to suffer a season-ending fracture. The Cats added Rodney Peete "Moss", Detroit QB-go-round.
- Just when you thought PA had their roster set, they made a trade. PA gets WR Rob Moore, 747s, for an incentive-based 1994 draft pick. If Moore scores less than 20 FFL points from now until the end of the season, VA receives PA's 5th round pick. If Moore scores 21-35 points, VA gets PA's 4th round pick. If Moore scores over 35 points, VA gets PA's 3rd round pick.
- Virginia still doesn't have a team name, DOUBLE DAMMIT!
- Virginia adds Leroy Thompson, RB, Stillers, to fill the Rob Moore's roster spot.
- Virginia then trades Leroy Thompson and a draft pick* to Richmond for Richmond's 4th round 1994 pick. *If Thompson scores more than 15 FFL points, RD gets VA's 6th round pick. If Thompson scores less than 15 FFL points, RD gets VA's 5th round pick.
- VA adds Kelvin Martin, WR, Hawks, to fill Thompson's roster spot.
- RD drops Vince Workman to make room for Leroy Thompson. Isn't it refreshing to see that Nick is not the only one that can come up with creative transaction clauses!
- Butler Blowfish drop Brett Perriman, WR, Lions; add Robert Smith (who they drafted, then dropped), RB, Norsemen. (They didn't play him this week either - 11 points).
- Butler drops Walter "Bubby" Brister, QB, Iggles; adds Johnny Bailey, RB, House of Cards.
- Miami Muffdivers add K Dean Biasucci, Colts; place Lawrence Dawsey, WR, Tampa Blah, on IR.
- Pittsburgh adds previously-dropped Mark Clayton, WR, Da Pack; drops RB Eric Dickerson, retired.
