HEARST SIGNS, DRAFTED NO. 1

TEN RUNNING BACKS
TAKEN IN FIRST ROUND

KEVIN MACK DRAFTED!

Garrison Hearst, who signed a contract with the Phoenix Cardinals the day before the draft, was the first player selected in this year's Fantasy Football League draft.

Running backs were at a premium, with 10 of the 12 first-round picks being running backs.

The Dallas Armadillos, cellar dwellars in last year's weak Southern Division, selected Hearst as the first pick. Central Division owners, gathered at the home of Wildcats owner Ron Yeany, gave the Dallas owner high marks for his draft strategy. It appears Dallas will improve significantly in a division that appears likely to be up for grabs again this year.

In the draft blunder of the day, Richmond Rattlin' Raptors owner Chris Lieberman selected RETIRED running back Kevin Mack in the fifth round.
