## KEVIN MACK UN-RETIRES!

Other owners wipe egg off their faces as Richmond's blunder becomes brilliance!

Kevin Mack, fifth round draft selection of the Richmond Rattlin' Raptors, announced recently that he will come out of retirement to run the ball again this year.

This comes as a HUGE surprise to fantasy league owners, who got quite a laugh at the expense of Richmond owner Chris Lieberman after he drafted the retired running back.

Sources close to the situation have told Fantasy Football Flyer that Mack's "retirement" was a ploy by the Rattlin' Raptors to land a "name" running back on their roster to appease their dwindling fan base in the absence of Emmitt Smith.

Officials in the commissioner's office had no comment but vowed to take whatever action necessary to uphold the integrity of the league.

Rumors that RB Terry Allen is working out in seclusion for his return to the NFL in a couple weeks were unconfirmed at press time. Allen was Richmond's 9th round pick who is "supposed" to remain on IR all year.

And Fran Tarkenton, working as a football analyst for TNT Sunday night in New Orleans, denied allegations that he has been in contact with Richmond and said he has "absolutely no plans to come out of retirement."

# Week 1 Game Summaries

LA Riot 73, SC Bandits 43

The Riot, powered by Dan Marino, three touchdown catches by Andre Reed and a huge Monday night by WR Alvin Harper, knocked off the defending champions soundly.

LA, last year's top money winner and high point winner, got off to a fast start again with the highest point total of all teams in week one.

These two teams meet again in week 11.

PN Penetrators 41, DS Armadillos 20  
Dallas' high hopes for a strong opening week were punctured by the Penetrators. Overall #1 draft pick Garrison Hearst flopped in his debut, with 3 yards on 7 carries.

Dallas' kicker also disappointed. Al DelGreco's three PATs were nearly erased by a botched 50-yard field goal attempt. Nearly all of Dallas' scoring came from QB Jim Kelly, who tossed 4 TDs.

Pennington was powered in part by RB Thurman Thomas, one of only 2 NFL running backs with 100+ yard games in the first week of action.

Miami 69, NJ Kings 57

Miami rode on the back of first round draft pick Brian Mitchell and a record-setting 22 points from kicker John Carney in a high-powered shootout between the league's most recent 30-year-old owners. New Jersey's 1-2 punch of QB Steve Young and WR Jerry Rice came up big in week one. Young had 3 TD tosses, 2 of them pulled in by Rice.

Miami QB Joe Montana scored 14 points for the as-yet-unnamed Miami squad. The 14 points eclipsed the entire 1992 output from Miami QBs.

NY Griffons 37, PA Wildcats 33

The Wildcats' WR woes continue in 1993, and a missed "chip" shot from K Chip Lohmiller was a 5-point swing that proved to be the difference as they lost to NY despite a blunder on the part of the NY owner who played a RB declared ineligible for week 1 play.

RB Harold Green did not sign a contract within the NFL-specified deadline for restricted free agents and was ineligible to play in week one. But NY, behind a stellar day from former Wildcat WR Herman Moore, put away the Wildcats. Three Wildcat WRs combined for a grand total of 2 points on the weekend.

RD Raptors 32, PG Pachyderms 31

Pachy's co-owner John Trzeciak saved fellow co-owner David Lieberman from committing a blunder -- but it wasn't enough.

Trzeciak made a last-minute roster change to ensure the Pachy's didn't start WR Mark Duper, dropped earlier last week by Philadelphia.

Richmond was powered behind the arm of John Elway and the leg of K Gary Anderson.

BR Blowfish 52, Virginia 36

The Blowfish, behind strong performances from WRs Sterling Sharpe and Tim Brown and K Morten Anderson downed the as-yet-unnamed squad from Virginia in the first of two consecutive meetings between these teams.

The match-up pitted the defending division champions from the Central and Southern divisions.

Blowfish QB Mark Rypien added 3 TDs Monday night to add frosting to the Blowfish cake. Butler was the only Central Division team to win.

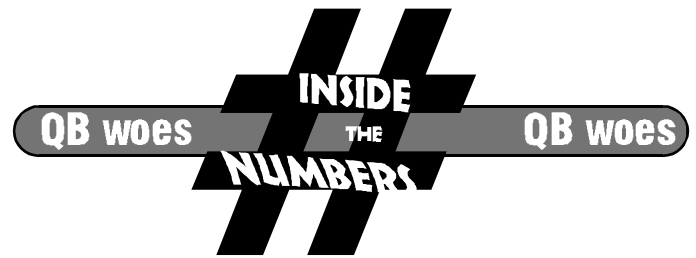
