SCANDAL IN BUTLERDOME!

Shocking allegations rock the defending Central Division champions

Scandal has rocked the Butlerdome, where the undefeated and defending Central Division champion Blowfish are feverishly preparing to tackle the undefeated and defending Coastal Division champion LARiot in Week 3.

Some of the shocking allegations uncovered this week and reported exclusively here in Fantasy Football Flyer are:

I Blowfish WR Irving Fryar has allegedly been involved with a now-pregnant Blowfish cheerleader. The cheerleader apparently wanted to see what Fryar allegedly waved at Lisa Olsen a few years back.

I Some small cracks have been discovered in the recently-built Butlerdome that could present problems later in the season when the snow begins to fall and playoffs are around the corner. Week 2 Game Summaries

LA Riot 33, NY Griffons 27

In a real squeaker that went down to the Monday night game, the Riot pulled out a slim victory over the Griffons.

The Riot's 31 points was the team's lowest regular-season score in the franchise's history. The previous low score for LA was a 36 point performance last year in a loss at Butler. PN Penetrators 31, NJ Kings 18

Watch out, Central Division. The Pennington Penetrators are 2-0. This despite owner Jim Waugh's efforts to render the Penetrators impotent: 1.) Drafting 9 players who are off in week 4; 2) Drafting a backup QB that has the same off weeks as the starting QB; and 3) Benching WR Michael Haynes, who turned in a 26-point performance which WOULD HAVE set the season-to-date record.

The King's royal combo of Steve Young and Jerry Rice were dismal. Young, the NFL's top-rated QB last season, has 6 INTs in 2 weeks.

Miami 42, PA Wildcats 40

Miami QB Boomer Esiason turned in a season-high 21-point performance as the as-yet-no-name team from Southern Florida beat the Wildcats.

The Wildcat owner was ready to celebrate victory with a TD from Tommy Vardell Monday night, but the Cleveland RB was bypassed on the goal-line for Defensive Tackle James Jones, who scored Cleveland's only rushing TD of the game.

SC Bandits 25, RD Raptors 21

Yes, Kevin Mack did un-retire. But now he is in a contract dispute. Emmitt Smith's holdout continues. And the Rattlin' Raptors are showing signs of going flatline for the season.

Not that the Bandits turned in a stellar performance for the week (or is that weak). Since there are no highlights from this snoozer, I'll take the editorial freedom to mention that this editor's team scored more points than all but one team this week, got a LOSS, and I have to write about these other pathetic performances.

BR Blowfish 31, Virginia 25

Virginia saw their starting QB get benched in the second half, saw a running back break his leg, set season-to-date lows for QB and Kicker, and still only lost by 6 points to the Blowfish. On the other hand, Butler's QB tore a knee ligament and is out for several weeks. But strong WRs (Sterling Sharpe, Tim Brown) and a solid kicker (Morten Anderson) saved the day for the Blowfish.

DS Armadillos 32, PG Pachyderms 21
Pachy co-owner "Trz" was hoping for a Dallas win, but he was talking about the Cowgirls. The other Dallas team, the Armadillos, evened their record at 1-1. 1st round pick Garrison Hearst improved over last week's performance with 76 yards, but he was sitting on the bench. The 'Dillos were boosted by kicker Al Del Greco, who booted 14 points. A bright spot for the Pachyderms was that they got 3 points for playing at home.

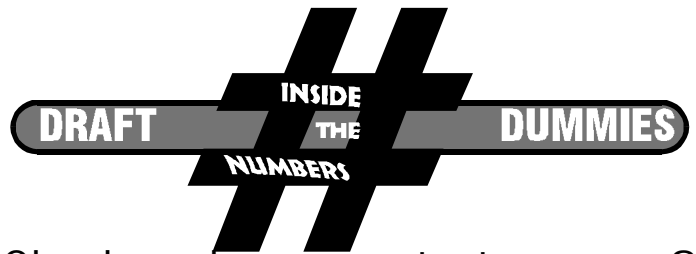
