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MARINO GONE FOR SEASON!

Star QB's injury deals serious blow to LA Riot!

Dan Marino, star quarterback for the undefeated LA Riot!, suffered a seasonending injury this week as he ruptured his Achilles tendon during a game in Cleveland. Marino had started in over 140 consecutive games.

Riot! backup QB Drew Bledsoe suffered a knee injury this week, and the 3rd LA QB, Jeff Hostetler, has had his bell rung several times during the season and watched from the bench as Vince Evans led a late charge forthe Raiders.

Week 6 Game Summaries TRANSACTIONS

MIMuffdivers 32, Virginia 5

Miami maintains it's 3-game lead in the Southern Division with a solid trouncing of the hapless team that STILLDOESN'THAVE A NAME!

The No-Namers set an historic low when QB Craig Erickson threw 4 interceptions, no TDs and no bonus yards (and an intentional grounding in the end zone for a touchback, just to liven things up on the day!)

Miami's RBs maintain the cumulative season point lead heading into this weekend's clash with the LA Riot!, the only other undefeated team in the league.

PN Penetrators 18, LA Riot! 51

The Riot! extended it's lead in the overall point race but was dealt a serious blow when QB Dan Marino went down for the season with an Achilles tear. Riot! WR Andre Reed added a solid 14-point performance Monday night to seal the deal.

Penetrators RB Thurman Thomas scored over half the team's points and was the only bright spot for Pennington as they suffer their fourth consecutive loss after opening the year 2-0.

NY Griffons 40, NJ Kings 36

In the closest contest of the week, the Griffons try to keep pace with the Riot! in the Coastal Division. TE Jackie Harris had a huge night for the Griffons with over 100 yards receiving in the first half alone.


