Miami, LA score come-from-behind wins in the Monday Night Mud Bowl

Riot! first-round draft pick Edgar Bennett tied the season-high output for a RB with a 3 TD, 26 point Monday Night Football performance that propelled LA to a comeback 20-point win over the Rattlin' Raptors. Bennett had scored a total of 10 points the entire season coming into this week.

On the other end of the Monday night spectrum, Miami RB Lewis Tillman eked out a 51 yard rushing game to provide the 2 points needed to give Miami a 56-54 win over the NY Griffons. The game, at Miami, was decided by home field advantage.

Pennsylvanja 78. Mercer 53

The 5-star game of the week proved to be a shoot-out, with Mercer's daunted and highly-touted defense nowhere to be seen. Number one overall draft pick Marshall Faulk paced the Wildcats with 20. Rodney Hampton's 19 and Barry Sanders' 11 contributed to the highest 3-RB total so far this season. 7 of 8 players have scored every week since Week 1 for the Wildcats. TE Ben Coates, who had scored positive points in every week so far this year, was the only Wildcat shut out on the weekend. Mercer had 6 of 8 players score, led by Andre Reed's 17, Keith Byars' 14 and recent QB acquisition Gus Frerotte added 10.

Los Angeles 60, Richmond 40

Edgar Bennett dressed up as Walter Payton for Halloween, and his Monday night performance at Soldier Field was reminiscent of Payton. The Riot! up their record to 4-5 and keep within striking distance in the Far-Flung Division. Richmond had a 16 point performance from QB John Elway, but left Floyd Turner's potential 8 points on the bench and attempted to start WR Isaac Bruce, who was on vacation with the rest of the Rams this week.

Virginia 59, Pittsburgh 43

Virginia RBs continue to pound the opposition - Harvey Williams pounded out 17 points, Chris Warren had 11 and Bam Morris had 8. Another Steeler, Yancy Thigpen, added 11. Pittsburgh was paced by kicker Steve Christie, who is second only to John Carney in K points this year. Appropriately starting on Halloween weekend, BOOmer Esiason added 9 points.

Miami 56, New York 54

Natrone Means passed Steve Young as the highest-scoring FFL player so far this year with a 14 point performance to help the Muffdivers edge the Griffons by the home field advantage. Miami coach Pat Landy also reportedly called in a last-minute lineup change, substituting Webster Slaughter with Rob Moore, which garnered an extra 6 points for the Muffdivers. John Carney added 9 points for Miami. New York was led by WR Herman Moore, whose 17 points marks his best performance of the season. Thurman Thomas added 11 and both K Jason Hanson and WR Michael Irvin added 8.

Wisconsin 31, State College 23

The Cheeseheads were paced by Terry Allen's 14 points and Herschel Walker's 12. Three receivers, however, were shut out on the weekend. The Bandits had no RB points and even attempted to start a vacationing RB, Derek Brown of the Saints. SC has the season's longest losing streak at 7.

Butler 20. Dallas 7

Leonard Russell and Tim Brown remain consistent for the Blowfish, but WR Sterling Sharpe was shut out again, and QB woes continue. Dallas could have posted a 24-20 win had they started QB Jim Kelly instead of Joe Montana.


