Cheeseheads face Wildcats for Fantasy Bowl 3 title

Two Wisconsin Cheesehead players scored 15 points in the Monday Night game to overcome an 11.5-point deficit and edge the Big Virginia Bang 67-62.5 to reach the Fantasy Bowl.

Wisconsin will play the Pennsylvania Wildcats, who avenged an early season loss to New York by defeating the Griffons 69.5-48. Pennsylvania and the Wisconsin franchise are each making their first appearance in the Fantasy Bowl.

Virginia will host New York this weekend in the game to determine 3rd and 4th places in the FFL.

The Butler Blowfish eliminated the Mercer Mustangs from the consolation bracket with a 58-33.5 win at Mercer. The Blowfish will travel to Miami to face the Muffdivers this week for the championship in the consolation bracket.

Fantasy Bowl 3 is shaping up as a winner-take-all scenario. Not only will this week's winner take the Championship, the overall point race is nearly deadlocked. Wisconsin gained 1 point on the Wildcats this week, stretching a slim lead from 3 to 4 points.

Cheesehead kicker Pete Stoyanovich's short field goal with just over 7 minutes to play in the Monday Night game propelled Wisconsin over the top in their game against Virginia. Ron Yeany, whose Wildcats wrapped up their victory Sunday afternoon over the Griffons, immediately called Wisconsin owner Dave Zilberfarb to wish the Cheeseheads good luck in the Fantasy Bowl.

A representative in the Wisconsin team offices answered the phone with the phrase "Championship Headquarobviously a reference to the Cheeseheads stellar season en route to their Far-Flung Division Champion-

Both team owners are looking forward to the match-up, which appeared destined to happen after Wisconsin's late-season trade with Richmond to acquire RB Emmitt Smith.

Analysis of the NFL games for the next two weeks leaves 2 big questions that will have a huge impact on the Fantasy Bowl and the overall point

1) This week for the Fantasy Bowl, Wildcat RBs Barry Sanders and Rodney Hampton are playing against the defenses of the Minnesota Vikings and the Philadelphia Eagles, respectively. These defenses shut out those two running backs in games earlier this year.

2) With home field advantage nearly clinched for the 49ers, will superstar Cheeseheads Steve Young and Emmitt Smith see limited action in the final week of the season?

Pennsylvania 69½, New York 48

Running backs Barry Sanders and Rodney Hampton scored 17 points each to pace the Wildcats. Kicker Jeff Jaeger had his most productive week of the season, adding 16 points. A move to Jeff Hostetler at quarterback backfired for the Wildcats, as his 6 points were 7 less than the usual starter Jim Everett would have posted. PA still has named Hostetler as the probable starter for the Fantasy Bowl. TE Ben Coates was the only Wildcat receiver CONTINUED INSIDE

to score on the weekend, hauling in his first TD since Week 6. New York was paced by 3 players who were not on the Griffon roster in Week 9: K Fuad Reveiz (15), WR Carl Pickens (14) and QB Stan Humphries (10). The other 5 Griffon starters scored only 9 points.

Wisconsin 67, Virginia 62½

Emmitt Smith and Steve Young, whose FFL scoring has left the rest of the league in the dust, paced the Cheeseheads with 20 and 16 points, respectively. Smith and Young are both averaging over 16 points each week and are the only FFL players to break the 200 mark this season (Smith 227, Young 225). The next closest player is Barry Sanders, averaging just over 12 points a week with a total of 169. RB Errict Rhett continues to come on strong for the Cheeseheads, adding 14 this week. The Big Bang was led by RB Chris Warren, whose 23 points keep him 4th overall in total points at 157. Seven of eight starters scored for the Big Bang, but kicker Chris Jacke was the only other player to score in double-digits, adding 16 to the Virginia effort.

Butler 58. Mercer 33½

Four Blowfish scored in double digits, paced by K Morten Anderson's 18. Sterling Sharpe added 17 and QB Jeff Blake pitched in Butler's second-best performance by a QB this year, with 10 points. In a move that seemed prophetic, Butler gave RB John L. Williams only his second start on the year. Williams responded with an 11-point week. Six of 8 starters for Mercer scored, led by QB Jeff George and WR Quinn Early, who added 8 apiece.

REMINDER to everyone to continue to turn in line-ups through the last weekend of NFL games.
