TRADING FRENZY PRECEDES DEADLINE

Tuesday night's deadline for submitting protected rosters saw a last-minute flurry of trade activity with several more big names changing teams going into the 1994 FFL Season.

Fantasy team dream but Super Bowl flop Thurman Thomas was the marquee name as 1993 FFL runner-up New York Griffons landed the stud running back they've been searching for since day one. The Griffons gave up new Altanta Falcon QB Jeff George, who many predict may be an FFL goldmine should he hit his potential in a new city.

The Butler Blowfish, faced with almost certainly having to cut one of their top WRs at the protection deadline, traded Irving Fryar to the Wisconsin Cheeseheads, who are starting to pick up the pieces in their receiving corps after last year's departure of Jerry Rice.

The Blowfish also gambled a 2nd round draft pick in hopes that RB Leonard Russell will be the big point-producing back that they've been seeking.

FFL Champion LA Riot! held a fire sale

and picked up 3 additional draft picks while dealing away Russell, WR Andre Reed and RB Tim Worley.

Dallas and Richmond made their second deal of the preseason, with the Armadillos acquiring RB Leroy Thompson for a 4th round pick.

State College Bandits also made two moves, dealing the talented new Green Bay Packer RB Reggie Cobb to the Pittsburgh Pachyderms and dealing Denver kicker Jason Elam to the LA Riot!

Receiving yardage, missed FGs are only proposed rules/scoring changes to pass

Fantasy points will start accumulating at 50 yards for wide receivers this year, and missed field goals 45 yards and over will only count as negative one under the 1994 FFL rules released by the commissioner's office this week.

Several other rules changes, many of them proposed by Dallas Armadillos owner and "self-appointed member of the Competition Committee" Paul Gilgallon, met with heated discussions in owner meetings but failed to carry a majority vote.

Gilgallon, in a letter to Fantasy Football Flyer, said the rule changes "were compiled through countless discussions with concerned owners over the past 2 FFL seasons. I am submitting these with the intent of having them voted on" by the owners prior to the August 14th protection deadline.

The letter also stated that "there may be variations of these rules that would make more sense, so any discussion can be used" to fine-tune the proposals. Dallas' correspondence also said "the intent of most of these rule changes is to address concerns regarding competition and the overall intent of the league, which is to have fun."

In addition, we here at FFF won't pass up the opportunity to allow the Dallas owner to pat us on the back. "I would also like to express the sincere gratitude of the Dallas Armadillos organization on the quality of the newsletters distributed by the FFF editor during the 1993/94 season. The Armadillos are looking forward to the upcoming season and most certainly the upcoming FFF

publications."

The 1994 FFL rules, sent to all owners recently, details the proposed rules changes. We'll offer just a quick re-cap here.

Proposition 1: The Dallas proposal suggested missed FGs of 41 yards or more be penalized only one point. The other half of the proposed changes in kick scoring suggested a two point penalty for missed PATs. The approved change only affects missed FGs 45 yard or above.

Proposition 2: Dallas' proposal for scoring receiving started at 50 yards and went in 25 yard bonus increments. The approved change starts yardage points at 50 yards but still only increases in 30 yard increments.

Proposition 3: Dallas suggested a 2 point penalty for interceptions. It was soundly defeated.

Proposition 4: Dallas suggests a 2 point home field advantage during the regular season and 3.5 points during playoffs. The issue is still under discussion.

Propositions 5 and 6: Dallas suggested several possible penalties for those owners who inconsiderately fail to call in lineups and report scores. The league office felt the penalties would be too difficult to police but did re-emphasize the importance of adhering to the rules for calling in lineups and scores to both the central office and your opponents.

Proposition 7: Dallas suggested a lotterytype drawing for draft picks of non-money winners, with the remaining draft picks being determined by money winners as in
