### GAME SUMMARIES:

### CAROLINA 73, PITTSBURGH 61

The Pachyderms finally have a hot week, and they run into a team even hotter. RB Chris Warren led the Big Bang, with 20 points. Three other starters scored in double-digits for Carolina -- QB Scott Mitchell had 19, former Pachyderm WR Curtis Conway had 14 and K Pete Stoyanovich had 12. Pittsburgh was led by QB Brett Favre, whose 21 points led all FFL players this week. Pittsburgh has also vaulted into first place for season high points at the QB position. Week 8 drop/add Ronnie Harmon added 12 for the Pachys.

### BUTLER 69, RICHMOND 42

The Blowfish receivers posted some big numbers on the weekend, but it was QB Jeff Blake who led the charge with 17 points. Receivers Brett Perriman, Eric Metcalf and Mark Chmura all scored in double digits. Richmond was led by RB Rashaan Salaam, who scored 14. QB Neil O'Donnell added 10.

## MERCER 66, PENNSYLVANIA 30

The Mustangs slammed the door on the season's longest winning streak, stopping the Wildcats at 6 consecutive wins. RB Terry Allen and WR Bert Emanuel each had huge days, scoring 20 points apiece. QB Jeff George added 16. The Wildcats were led by RB Marshall Faulk, who scored 14, and K Jeff Jaeger, who added 11.

# NEW YORK 51, STATE COLLEGE 23

Those Griffon WRs continue to post huge numbers, regardless of who is plugged into the lineup. WR Isaac Bruce said "who is this Rice guy" and went out to post 14 points. Bruce is the highest scoring WR in the league. Herman Moore and Carl Pickens each added 11. State College was paced by K Matt Stover who chipped in 9 and RB Terry Kirby who added 8.

# MIAMI 49, DALLAS 44

Three Muffdiver starters scored in double digits, led by WR Jeff Graham, who chipped in 14. RB Natrone Means scored 11 and QB Steve Bono added 10. The Armadaillos were paced by WRs Henry Ellard and Jerry Rice, who scored 14 each. QB Chris Miller tied a dubious record. His negative 4 points tied this season's AND the all-time LOW record for an individual performance at the QB position.

### WISCONSIN 44, LOS ANGELES 33

Only 4 starters scored for the defending champs, but that was enough against a Riot! team who went back into hibernation. RB Errict Rhett paced the Cheeseheads with 17, and K Jason Hanson added 12. 7 of 8

starters scored for the Riot!, but none of them in double digits. QB Drew Bledsoe led the charge, with 9 points, while RB Edgar Bennett added 8.
