

NEW YORK FACES WISCONSIN FOR FANTASY CHAMPIONSHIP

The NY Griffons, on a roll all season after suffering only one loss all year, will face the defending champion Wisconsin Cheeseheads for the FFL Championship. New York advanced to the finals with a 83½ - 68 win over the Pennsylvania Wildcats. PA is knocked out of championship contention despite scoring the second highest point total of everyone on the week. Wisconsin will advance to a second consecutive Fantasy Bowl after a 56½ - 44 win over the Big Carolina Bang.

PLAYOFF SCORES:

NY 83½, PA 68

Jim Kelly, Thurman Thomas and Herman Moore all scored 17 each to pace the Griffons. RB Adrian Murrell more than doubled his season-to-date total with 8 points. Only Tyrell Davis failed to score for the Griffons. RB Curtis Martin's 23 points led the Cats.

WN 56½, CL 44

Steve Young (21) and Emmitt Smith (14) led the Cheeseheads as they attempt to be the first repeat champion in FFL history. Chris Warren (20) and Scott Mitchell (11) led the Big Bang.

LA 51½, RD 43

The Riot! advances to the consolation championship game at State College with the win over the Raptors. LA was paced by Ricky Watters' 14 points. Rashaan Salaam (14) and Gary Anderson (12) paced Richmond.

SC 37

Warren Moon and Derek Loville paced the Bandits with 12 apiece. State College will host the consolation championship vs. LA.

Five Pachyderms scored 8 points each - only TE Troy Drayton failed to post numbers for PG.

BR 50

Blowfish kicker Morten Anderson set the season's kicking record with a 20 point performance to pace BR.

MR 42

Kicker Norm Johnson (17) and RB Terry Allen (14) led the Mustangs.

DS 24

WR Jerry Rice led the Armadillos with 8 points.

MI 19

WR Brian Blades led the Muffdivers with 8 points. Miami has now slipped to last place in total points for quarterbacks as well as kickers, and is only 9 points out of the cellar for RB points.
