GAME SUMMARIES:

MIAMI 69, DALLAS 59

The Muffdivers did indeed get lucky, having been forced to start WR Rob Moore in place of WR Brian Blades, who was called in to Central but couldn't start because his NFL team was off. Moore tied WR Jeff Graham for second highest score for Miami, with 17 points apiece. RB Natrone Means broke out of his slump big time, scoring a team-high 20 points. Dallas was paced by big games for WR Yancy Thigpen (17), WR/GOD Jerry Rice (14) and QB Chris Miller (14) subbing for the off-week Dan Marino.

PENNSYLVANIA 67, BUTLER 45

Wildcat RB Rodney Hampton broke out of his early season slump with a monster afternoon that included 4 TDs and came 1 rushing yard short of tying the all-time FFL record set by Emmitt Smith in week 2 of this year. Hampton scored 35 points for the Wildcats. QB Jim Everett chipped in 15 and the 3 PA wide receivers added 13 points. The Blowfish were led by QB Jeff Blake, whose 23 points was second-highest among all players in Week 4. RB Craig Heyward enjoyed his second consecutive 100 yard week and posted 8 points.

WISCONSIN 67, LOS ANGELES 38

Emmitt Smith continues to just dominate this league, leading all RBs and adding another 22 points this weekend. Steve Young chipped in another 15 points and continues to lead the league at the QB position. Errict Rhett added 14 points. TE Jay Novacek chipped in 6, K Greg Davis added 7. Three Cheesehead WRs all took goose-eggs. The Riot! was led by WR Cris Carter, with 14 points, K Jason Elam chipped in 8 and QB Jeff Hostetler added 7.

PITTSBURGH 59, STATE COLLEGE 42

The Pachyderms finally won their first game of the year, paced by three starters in double-digits. RB Robert Smith and WR Darnay Scott led the Burghers with 14 points each. Former Nittany Lion TE Troy Drayton added 11 points, and QB Brett Favre chipped in 9. The Bandits were paced by RB Harvey Williams, who scored 14 points, and K Chris Boniol, who added 10.

CAROLINA 48, NEW YORK 40

WRs Carl Pickens and Herman Moore each added 8 points.

The previously unbeaten Richmond Raptors took a big turn South this past weekend and set the season-to-date low for team score. Only Michael Irvin's 5 points and Gary Anderson's 4 saved the Raptors from extreme embarrassment. The Mustangs pick
